My dear fellow Disciplers,

Psalm 119 begins with these words:



How blessed are those whose way is blameless,

Who walk in the law of the Lord.

How blessed are those who observe His testimonies;

Who seek Him with all their heart.

Take a moment to think about those words. I hope they resonate with the desires of your heart. As you read and study God's Word, discuss it with others and apply it to your life, as Disciplers studies encourage us to do. These words should reflect more and more your heart's desire and your everyday actions.

I pray that studying and fellowshipping in God's Word is drawing you closer to Him and has brought you to love and cherish His Word more and more every week. But there's something else you can do as well, that will add depth and detail to your study. You can commit to read ALL of God's Word. Reading your Bible from cover to cover is a wonderful blessing. You may face challenges along the way. It takes commitment and prayer. But what a joy it is when you close your Bible after reading that last chapter in Revelation. **You'll want to do it again!**

For many years, my husband and I read the Bible together every night. Starting in Genesis, we read aloud, alternating nights, just one chapter each night. We made God's Word the last word every night, the perfect way to end the day. After my husband passed away, I began reading through the Bible every year. I counted the pages in my Bible, divided by 365, and read that number of pages every day. I did that for over 10 years.

At the beginning of this year, a friend and I decided to read through the Bible together, three chapters a day. **It has been a daily joy in my life**. My friend and I live on opposite sides of the USA, but we keep in touch with text messages daily, sharing precious insights we've gleaned, passages that brought us to our knees, or whatever the Holy Spirit has laid on our hearts. It's okay if we need to skip a day now and then, but it's important to stick with it!

It's wonderful to be in a Bible study and concentrate on one portion of Scripture, but it's even better when you also **read the big picture, the whole of God's Word.** The Bible is deep and wide and full of the knowledge of God, His Law, His promises, His ways, His works, His power, His mercy, grace and love. When you start reading through from beginning to end, you will be amazingly blessed, I promise!

Whether you read on your own or along with someone else, you can make the guidelines for your journey. (Hint: start in the summer when you're not involved in a group study). Make it a habit that you'll never want to quit. I'll be praying for you!
